COUNTY BUDGET FY16

Upon motion by Mr. Hendrick, seconded by Mr. Hutchins the Board approved and appropriated the Fiscal Year 2016 Carroll County General operating total expenditures of \$41,853,248 for the general fund, and \$15,000 for the Law Library fund and appropriate those amounts presented by department. I also ask the Board to adopt the Calendar 2015 tax rates as advertised and heard at our public hearing on May 11th. With the previously adopted school budget in the amount of \$40,596,033 the total FY 2016 County General Operating and Law Library fund Budgets are \$82,464,281.00

Adopted Rates for Calendar 2015 Tax Year
