

## ORDER

VIRGINIA: IN THE CIRCUIT COURT OF CARROLL COUNTY

All courts in the Commonwealth of Virginia are currently under a judicial order from the Virginia Supreme Court. This order is dated May 6, 2020, and available for public inspection. It remains in effect from May 18, 2020 through June 7, 2020, and subject to amendment.

On May 26, 2020, the Governor of this Commonwealth entered Executive Order 63, which mandates facial coverings in certain circumstances.

On May 11, 2020, this court issued an order that is effective from May 18, 2020, through June 7, 2020. This order remains in effect, and all are encouraged to read it. It explains the course of operation during this time.


This order explains the use of facial coverings in the courtroom pursuant to Executive Order 63.

Whenever members of the public are present in the courtroom, everyone in the courtroom will wear a facial covering, subject to the exceptions described in Executive Order 63 and/or exceptions deemed reasonable by the presiding judge based on current circumstances.

If the courtroom is populated only by sworn officers of the court but not by the public, facial coverings shall be optional.

This order is subject to augmentation and amendment at any time.
