

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING CONCERNING THE INTENTION OF
THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF CARROLL COUNTY, VIRGINIA TO PROPOSE
FOR PASSAGE A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF AN
ESTIMATED MAXIMUM OF \$6,700,000 PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF GENERAL
OBLIGATION SCHOOL REFUNDING BONDS, SERIES 2022 FOR THE PURPOSE OF
REFINANCING THE DESIGN, ACQUISITION, CONSTRUCTION, AND EQUIPPING
OF PUBLIC SCHOOL FACILITIES**

Notice is hereby given to all interested persons of a public hearing concerning the intention of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Carroll, Virginia (**the “County”**), to propose for passage at a regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors of the County to be held on Monday, March 14, 2022 at 6:00 p.m. or as soon thereafter as possible, in the Board Meeting Room of the Carroll County Government Center located at 605 Pine Street, Hillsville, Virginia, a resolution authorizing the issuance of an estimated maximum of \$6,700,000 principal amount of general obligation school bonds of the County. The proposed uses for which more than ten percent of the bond proceeds are expected to be used are the refunding and refinancing of capital costs related to HVAC projects, an Agriculture STEM lab and gas transmission lines within the district school buildings originally financed by the Industrial Development Authority of Carroll County, Virginia Lease Revenue Bond, Series 2014, and include costs of issuance of the Bond, all of which constitute capital projects for public school purposes. The Bond will be sold to the Virginia Public School Authority.
